#### 2010 Planning Process Update:

Throughput projections are still needed from Minnesota and OneNet. Kent will send Dave and Von spreadsheets to fill out.

Von was put on the spot by Kent asking him to join the planning sub-committee during the call. Von accepted. Thanks Von!

The 2nd 10Gig connection to I2 is physically connected to the I2 Infinera gear and is being back hauled to Chicago, and this will be used for CPS traffic, until the Transit Rail/CPS merger is complete. Changes could be made after that time.

Jeff mentioned that Omni Pop has also ordered a 2nd 10 Gig link, they will connect it to the Chicago router, where their current connection is, as most of their members have redundancy.

He offered a 10 Gig connection from Chicago to KC as a backup connection for the Giga Pop members that did not have redundancy in Chicago and for GPN to have a back up path to I2 in Chicago. This will be considered in the GPN planning sub committee.

#### Status of Service Requests:

10 Gig to ESNet is physically connected. WiscNet will work with GPN NOC and ESNet to set up a back up peering connection.

2nd 10 Gig connection to I2 is physically connected. (See above)
